

Corona-protocol Open Dutch Championship 2020

In the description below we explain the rules and regulations that make it possible for us to organize regattas at this moment in time;

General rules for all:

- Using common sense is key
- o If showing signs related to COVID-19 stay home and get tested
- Directly return home when during the sports activities symptoms occur like; nose-cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, (light) coughing, wheeziness, rise in body temperature, fever and/or sudden loss of taste or smell.
- Keep 1,5 mtr distance between people of 18 years or older (exception during sportsactivities)
- Avoid crowds
- Wash hands with soap and water often Do not shake hands
- During registration we will ask Corona check questions and ask you to sign this form o Please be patient
- You have not visited a (due to COVID-19) orange or red colored area/country in the last 14 days
- You have not been in contact with a person(s) infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days

Sailors may refrain from the 1,5 mtr rule during the races. After racing the 1,5 mtr rule will be in effect once again. The Yachtclub Braassemermeer is not responsible if attendees disregard the rules. Sailors and visitors are solely responsible for keeping the correct distance.

The 1,5 mtr rule needs to be respected in all cases; at the crane, during rigging and de-rigging, on the docks as well as on the parking lot and the camper area.

Follow the instructions of the supervisors an volunteers.

In the members-area and on the balcony of the clubhouse the restaurant/bar rules are in effect. This means reservation in advance, check questions at entering and only seated places available. This will also be the case when or if eating and drinking takes place on the grounds and or in the tent.

- Information booth; location to be announced at the beginning of the event. After the enddate of registration no further contestants can be admitted.
- The regatta office is only accessible for the necessary volunteers of the specific event. Protests will be handled at 1,5 mtr. Hands need to be disinfected when entering the juryroom.
- o Prize-giving; if possible this will take place outside. This unfortunately cannot be done inside.

The safety and health of competitors as well as volunteers must prevail during our regattas, If circumstances change and this safety cannot be guaranteed we can and will stop/cancel the event. In the event of new and more stringent rules this too can have effect on the event. If competitors neglect to follow the rules provided, the board, chief racing officer and or the protest committee can decide to exclude a competitor without a hearing.
